Social consensus regarding the conservation and sustainable development of the WHS

The Public Council as a non-governmental organization is the most acceptable way of coordination and cooperation development of all stakeholders.

Establishment of the Public Council

In order to implement the decisions taken the Public Council has the right:

- to apply to the authorities of various levels;
- to address complaints about verifying the legitimacy of the decisions taken;
- to nominate representatives of the Council for participation in meetings of the State Environmental Review;
- to propose the issues concerning the objectives of the Council for consideration at referendums of different levels (local, regional).

Development of the local community

- preservation and development of traditional environmental management (including traditional forms of farming)
- preservation and maintenance of historical and cultural elements (chapels, etc.)
- conservation, restoration and reconstruction of traditional houses and household structures
- preservation and development of the unique traditional culture of the Russian North

Scientific and Educational activity regarding the WHS and Information support

The main directions of the museum scientific work are:

- Study of the architectural heritage of the Kizhi Museum;
- Scientific research of museum items related to the WHS and folk culture of Karelia;
- Historical and ethnographic study of the traditional culture of the peoples of Karelia;
- Historical and area study of the Kizhi surroundings;
- Study of the folklore heritage of Zaonezhie;
- Study of the Orthodox culture;
- Study of the archaeological heritage;
- Researches of ecology and environmental protection.

Scientific and Educational activity regarding the WHS and Information support

Development of the museum and educational activity:

- Development of Children's Center educational programs;
- Development of excursion work, training and skills development of guides;
- Development of exhibition programs;
- Organization and carrying out of traditional feasts and interactive festive programs with the use of museum reconstruction elements and museum animation;
- Creation of educational distance resources: virtual Internet projects, museum photo- and video archives.

Action plan (2014 - 2020)

Achievement of social consensus:

- Establishment of the Public Council
- Development of interaction with regions of the republic
- Introduction of the system of public reports and round table discussions
- Creation of a system of continuous information support of the museum activity

- Development of scientific ethnographic materials
- Participation in national and international scientific and research programs and projects
- Improving excursion work including training courses and professional (skills) development of guides

- Organization of training and skill development of the WHS stakeholders
- Creation of the training center on conservation of wooden architecture monuments and organization of its work
