It is relevant that the conservation of a structural wooden construction include every effort necessary to maintain together with the most possible of its material, the resistant function.

Repair

Repair is a painstaking intervention in a wooden element, aiming at replacing only decayed parts and otherwise leaving the structure and the materials intact

Repair consists in the actions aimed to recover the whole or part of the lost structural efficiency of a wooden element or frame.

Reinforcement

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Reinforcement consists in the actions aimed to increase the structural efficiency of element, ensemble of elements or a structure, adapting them to the new an conditions.
